- 1. How much of the world's landmass is covered with rainforest ? 7%
- 2. Where can you find tropical rainforests ? around the equator, South America, central Africa, southern India, Indonesia etc..
- 3. Why are tropical rainforests so important for us. Give a few reasons ! produce food and medicine, regulate the climate , provide energy, produce wood , give us fresh air
- 4. The largest rainforest in the world is the Amazon rainforest
- Describe the yearly temperatures in the rainforest. temperatures stay the same the whole year round – about 20° to 30° C
- 6. Describe the soils in the rainforest . not very fertile; nutrients are washed out
- 7. Name the four layers of vegetation in the rainforest ? canopy, subcanopy, understory, flood
- 8. Name a few plants of the rainforest : ferns, orchids, lianas , palm tree, rubber tree
- 9. Plants that climb around trees are called lianas
- 10. Latex comes out of the rubber tree
- 11. Why is the rainforest important for our climate ? takes up rain, prevents floods and droughts
- 12. What type of fish is a piranha. Where does it live ? fish with sharp teeth; attacks other fish and humans ; Amazon river
- 13. What are indigenous people ? people who have always lived in the same place and have little contact with others
- 14. When farmers grow crops on a piece of land for a short time and then move on to the next area, it is called **shifting cultivation**
- 15. Name reasons for deforestation : need for wood, energy , raw materials (iron ore, gold, silver) , dams are built, farming land
