- evergreen = when a plant or tree does not lose its leaves in the winter
- **fern** = plant with green leaves that look like feathers, but with no flowers
- **fertile** = able to produce a lot of crops and food
- **firewood** = wood that you collect to make a fire
- **flood** = a large area of water that covers a place that is usually dry
- **fluid** = watery, liquid
- furniture = large objects in the house that are mostly made of wood, like chairs, tables, cupboards
